Miville Ménard Award

Miville Ménard was short in stature but everything he did was big! Miville was a leader, a dreamer, a man of action and an excellent team player. He would set challenging goals and never take no for an answer. His goals were attained because of his positive attitude and endless energy. His enthusiasm was infectious. His friends and colleagues fondly remember his warmth, sense of humour and generosity.

As an alumnus, Miville was a member of AIESEC Canada's Board of Directors. He was a great proponent of alumni engagement and played a key role in winning the bid for International Congress 2002 to be hosted in Canada. In 2002, Miville Menard was inducted into AIESEC International's Hall of Fame. Upon graduating from l'Université Laval, Miville began an illustrious career with Cossette Communications. One of his biggest accomplishments was winning the Canadian English-language McDonald's account.

Nomination and Award Process

Starting in 2008, AIESEC Local Committees in good standing will be invited to nominate an alumnus or external supporter that has shown outstanding individual contributions to AIESEC. Nominations will be reviewed by an awards committee established by the Board of Directors of AIESEC Canada. The Miville Ménard Award for Excellence in Leadership will be presented annually at the organization's National Conference in January.
